How to Engage in the Virtual EFAO Conference

The Virtual Conference format is new for everyone this year, and here are some ways that you can make the most out of your experience.

Join Virtually

- The conference will use Zoom as the platform for all conference sessions, meetings and socials.
- To connect, make sure you have Zoom downloaded on your computer or mobile device. You will also need to create an account.
- The Zoom Support Quick Start Guide for New Users is helpful if you are new to Zoom.
- Ensure that your connection and operating system meets the Zoom requirements.
- After downloading and setting up your account, customize your Zoom profile by adding a photo (it will appear when your camera is off). Be sure that your Zoom name also represents how you'd like to be identified in the session.
- You will always have the option to join by phone if your internet connection is unreliable – numbers will be sent by email along with links. You will also be able to watch session recordings.

Attend a Conference Session
